

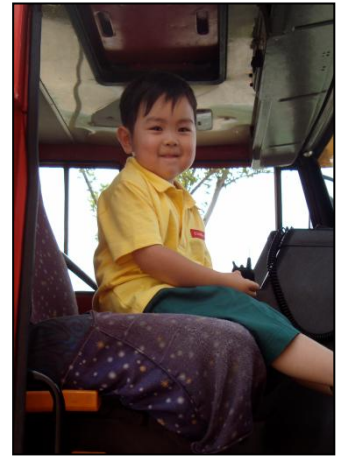
Nursery Pandas Newsletter
